How Does the Program Work?

Reading to Kids organizes reading clubs on the second Saturday of each month at elementary schools near the downtown Los Angeles area. These schools are located in low-income neighborhoods where the majority of students are English language learners.

From 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m., volunteers gather at our partner elementary schools to read aloud to children. Volunteers also help the children create craft projects related to the monthly theme and assist in distributing a free book to every child. The books that are read at each reading club are then donated the school’s library.
