WHO WE ARE: Reading to Kids is a grassroots organization dedicated to inspiring underserved children with a love of reading. On the second Saturday of each month, we organize about 700 children and 250 volunteers into reading clubs at four Los Angeles elementary schools. Since its inception, Reading to Kids has given more than 38,000 books to children who attend the reading clubs and donated more than 6,000 books to school libraries.
